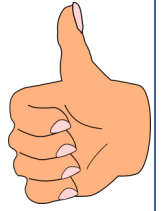


February Aromas Grange Newsletter

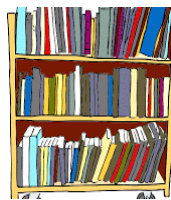
