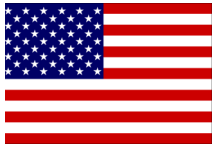

Community Members are \$5

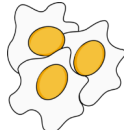
Grange will provide all meat, bread, beans, veggie-burgers & drinks. You bring a dish to share.
